Party or tribunal appointed experts

Common law versus civil law tradition

# Part 35 Civil Procedure Rules

- Implemented many Woolf Report recommendations:
  - experts' overriding duty of independence;
  - disclosure of party instructions;
  - restriction of expert evidence




 Proposed numerous reforms to reduce expert partiality

#### **Issues in International Arbitration**

Party-appointed experts overwhelmingly common in IA

90% of all experts used in arbitrations are party-





#### **Issues in International Arbitration**

Concerns in common law translated to IA

 Bias of partyappointed arbitral experts Challenges for arbitrators and counsel from civil law backgrounds

 Inexperience with problems requiring reform in common law jurisdictions 3

The Challenge: inefficient evidentiary hearings and expert bias



The Solution: limiting the differences

# **Proposed Best Practice Directions**

- 1. Identification of disciplines
- 2. Establishment of common list of questions
- 3. Deferral of production of expert reports until factual evidence is available
- Production of joint expert reports identifying areas of agreement and disagreement
- 5. Production of individual expert reports on areas on disagreement only
- Production of "reply" expert reports that conduct a "figures-as-figures" analysis
